



EVER WONDER.... IS IT A TRUE EMERGENCY? WHERE SHOULD I GO?

CALL PINON FAMILY PRACTICE FIRST:

(WE NEARLY ALWAYS HAVE SAME DAY APPOINTMENTS – DON'T WAIT TO CALL!)
MONDAY – THURSDAY WE HAVE A LIMITED # OF ACUTE APPOINTMENTS 5PM - 7PM

- Sprains, Strains and Broken Bones
- Stitches/Wound Assessment
- Minor Injuries
- Coughs, Colds, Sore throats
- Ear Aches, Back aches, Headaches
- Eye, Sinus or Urinary Tract Infections
- Vomiting, Diarrhea, Upset Stomach
- Minor Dermatitis/Allergic Reactions (not with airway/respiratory problem)
- Flu Symptoms, COVID19, Fever, Cough, SOB, Headache
- Pink Eye/Conjunctivitis

WHEN TO GO TO URGENT CARE/PHARMACY CLINIC: For any of the above conditions - <u>outside</u> of our normal business hours and as directed by our on-call provider

OUR RECOMMENDATIONS FOR NON-EMERGENT, AFTER HOURS CARE:

- Don't wait until the end of the day to call us/send a portal message
- Nights and weekends CALL OUR PROVIDER ON CALL
- Remember: Urgent Care and ER copay's are higher than your PCP
- \$\$Hospital owned Urgent Care (and satelite ER's) charge an additional "facility fee" resulting in a <u>much</u> higher out of pocket cost to you/your insurance (UC Health, SCL, CENTURA, HCA - hospital owned facilities)
- \$\$When we say "Go to the ER" we mean "GO TO A MAIN HOSPITAL CAMPUS ER" not a satelite ER/UC. There is a difference! (Specialty care and imaging is limited at satelite facilities, therefore resulting in additional costs, a waste of time and sometimes, medical transport)



We will always have a provider on-call outside of normal office hours (including holidays) to help guide you for NON-EMERGENT CARE
